And they will have to cut their own wood for their fires, and they will do it with a buck saw, no modern chain saws; very primitive will they be. Their work will be making trails through the forest, and going on long hikes etc. and doubtless they will find plenty for them to do.

There are several camps similar in existence, and it is pretty much on a trial basis. It will be somewhat like the CCC camps that President Roosevelt put in motion, during the bad financial depression, which many of you do not remember, but some do. I was only 6 years old at the time, and I know money was scarce. I thought Dad should just write out a check, and did not know anything about finances. Those were the good old days, when about everyone was connected with farming, etc. But now one man has 130 cows, and this leaves the other potential farmers to seek other employment. But the reason we have so much crime, is because of the easy life many boys have. They are not taught to work, and they plan to live the life of thugs.
